Sizable donation by the Blum family

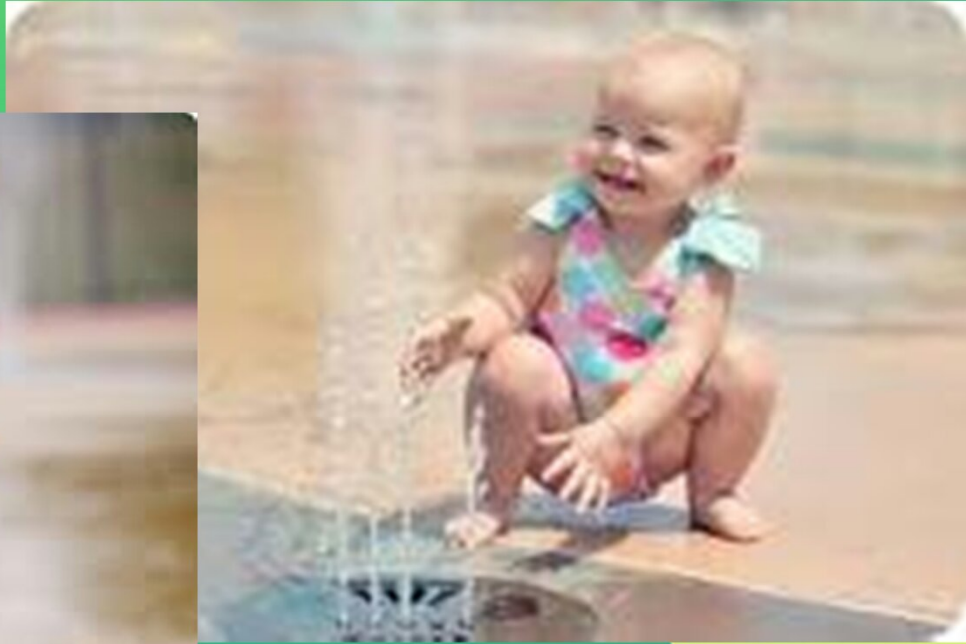
The wishes of the family are to construct a water-based activity which can be enjoyed by all ages in Ashton

What is a Splash Pad?



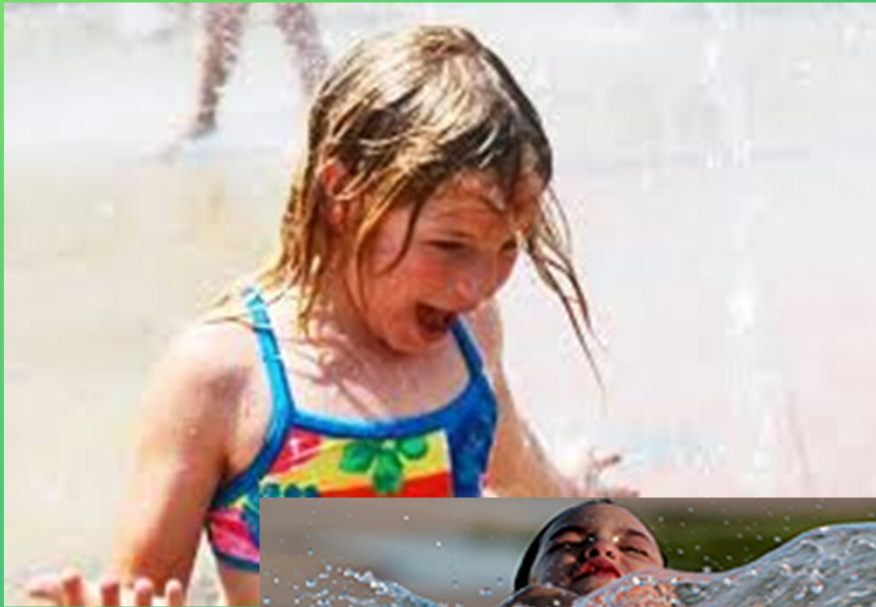
A splash pad is an area for water play that has no standing water.

Advantages

**People enjoy seeing, hearing,
experiencing moving water**

Serves all swimming abilities

**Requires minimal staffing with auto
shut-off feature**

Practically no risk of drowning

More Advantages

Very accessible to people with disabilities

Not a pool-cannot learn to swim

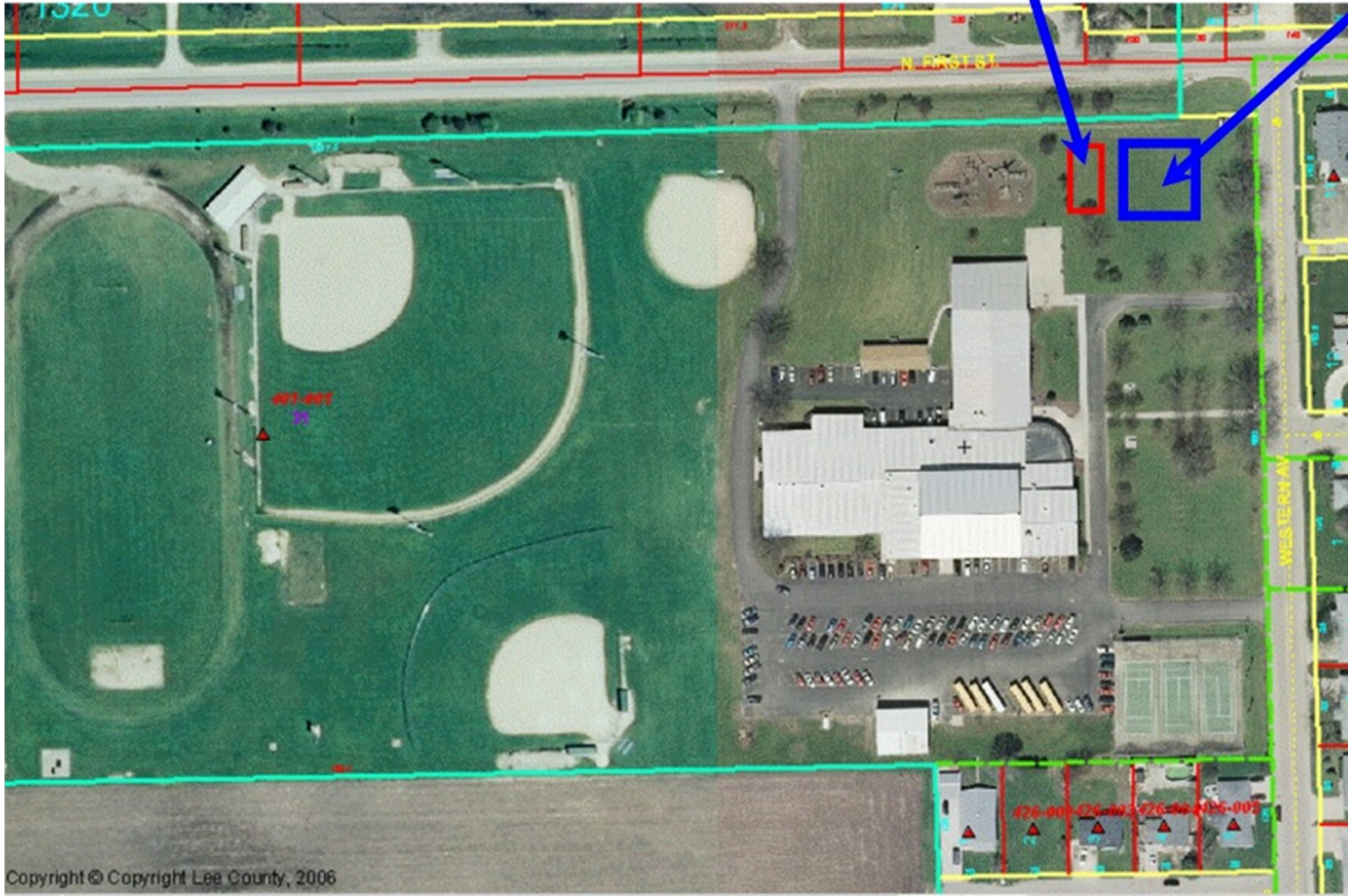
